Prostate Scotland is delighted to be named as the chosen charity for the Erskine Golf Club Pro/Am in September.

"More men in Scotland need to be getting checked to detect prostate cancer earlier on. It's the most common cancer in men, impacting 1 in 10 men in Scotland, and the figures are rising.

"It's important for men to know that early-stage prostate cancer doesn't always show symptoms, and with no national screening programme for prostate cancer in Scotland or the UK, Prostate Scotland advises men from the age of 50 to go to their GP and request a prostate-specific antigen (PSA) test.

"Men who are "high risk of developing prostate cancer", those with a family history – grandad, dad, uncle, brothers, and Afro-Caribbean men, are advised to get tested as early as 45."
